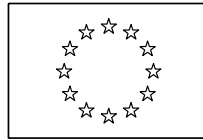

Visa for Language Courses in Germany

- The German Embassy Yangon does not issue long term visa (for stays longer than three months) for other Schengen partners. For language courses in other European countries please contact the competent Embassy in Myanmar, Thailand or another country.
- The application cannot be submitted earlier than 3 months before the travel date.
 - The processing time for visas for language courses of up to 90 days takes 3 days.
 - The processing time for visas for language courses of more than 90 days usually takes 4 to 6 weeks.
- You have to make an appointment via the [online appointment system](#).
- A **processing fee of EUR 60.00** applies. It needs to be paid in USD at the current exchange rate. Please note that only clean and unfolded bank notes will be accepted. The Embassy does not accept dirty, folded or ripped USD notes.
- Please provide **original documents and two copies**. Original documents will be returned. All documents and certificates in Burmese have to have a notarized English translation attached.

| 6. | Proof of previous education degrees with notarized English translation | |

Usually this letter can be submitted to the Immigration Authorities (Ausländerbehörde) or the Registry Office (Meldeamt) in Germany. The letter has to cover the whole duration of the stay.</p> <p><u>OR</u></p> <p>b.) Self-financing (bank statements)</p> | |
| 10. | Proof of existing knowledge of the German language (for example certificates of attendance of language classes). Existing knowledge will be examined by the consular officer. | |
| 11. | Evidence of personal living conditions in Myanmar i.e. if applicable your marriage certificate and children's birth certificates. | |
