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## Visa for University Studies

- The German Embassy Yangon does not issue long term visas (for stays longer than three months) for other Schengen partners. For studies at a University in other European countries please contact the competent Embassy of your destination country.
- The application should be submitted as early as possible, but no more than three months before the intended travel date. The processing time for the visa is usually four weeks.
- Please arrange an appointment via the [online appointment system](#).
- A non-refundable **processing fee of EUR 75.00** applies, to be paid in cash and USD at the Embassy's exchange rate. Visa applications for students who have been granted full scholarships from public funds are processed free of charge.
- Please provide **all documents in original with two copies**. Original documents will be returned. All documents and certificates in Myanmar language have to be accompanied by a notarized translation into English.

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1. **2 application forms for national visa** duly completed in German or English and signed.

2. **2 identical recent photographs** no more than 6-months old, 35–40mm in width, white background, close up of your head and top of your shoulders so that your face takes up 70–80% of the photograph, in sharp focus and clear. No Photoshop!

3. **Original passport** valid for at least 3 months after your visa has expired. The passport must contain at least two blank pages. The date of issue must not be older than 10 years.

4. **Admission letter** of the German University or the "Studienkolleg"

5. **Proof of previous education** (graduation) with certified English translation

6. **Proof of sufficient funds**, at least 853,00 € per month (**861 € from 01.11.2020**) for the planned study visit. For long term studies the full amount of 10,236 € (**10.332 € from 01.11.2020**) for the first study year has to be proved when applying for the visa. For subsequent study years substantiation of a plausible financing perspective is sufficient.

The financing can be verified by:

- Establishing a **blocked account in Germany** in the amount of 10.236 (10.332 €).
- You have free choice of provider. Information on providers that offer this service worldwide is available on the [Federal Foreign Office website](#).

7.	<b>Proof of sufficient knowledge of the academic language</b> (e.g. for <b>GERMAN</b> certificate B1 by Goethe-Institute, for <b>ENGLISH</b> TOEFL, IELTS etc.)	
8.	<b>Letter of motivation plus curriculum vitae</b>	
9.	<p><b>Travel/medical insurance</b> German health insurance for students</p> <p><b>In case you do not have a German insurance policy</b> before moving to Germany please kindly provide us with: <u>Travel/medical insurance for the first three month of your stay</u> (coverage for medical expenses EUR 30,000 and valid for the entire Schengen area). It is a requirement that claims against the insurance company are recoverable in the Schengen States and/or Liechtenstein. The <u>insured party</u>, <u>policy validity period</u>, <u>geographical coverage</u> and <u>schedule of benefits</u> must be mentioned.</p>
