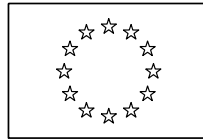

Family Reunion (Child)

- The German Embassy in Yangon issues visas to applicants **living in the Republic of the Union of Myanmar**. If you intend your minor child to join you in Germany, you need to apply for a visa for family reunion (child) (national visa).
- The application cannot be submitted earlier than 3 months before the travel date. **The processing time can be up to several weeks or months**. You are strongly encouraged to submit your application at least two months before your intended departure from Myanmar.
- You have to make an appointment via the [online appointment system](#).
- A **processing fee of 37.50 EUR** applies. It needs to be paid in USD at the embassy's exchange rate. There is no refund of the processing fee in case your application is denied or revoked.
- Please provide **original documents and two copies**. Original documents will be returned. All documents and certificates in Myanmar language have to be accompanied by a notarized translation into English.

1. **2 application forms for national visa**, duly completed in German or English and signed

You can download the [application form](#) from the embassy's website.

Please note that applications for children under the age of 18 years need to be signed by all persons holding legal custody for the child (usually both parents). These signatures must be effected in front of a visa officer. In case the visa applicant is intended to join a person who holds legal custody for the child and is living in Germany, this person's signature is not required, however.

2. **2 identical recent photographs** no more than 6-months old, 35–40mm in width, white background, close up of your head and top of your shoulders so that your face takes up 70–80% of the photograph, in sharp focus and clear. No Photoshop!

3. **Original passport** valid for at least 3 months after your visa has expired. The passport must contain at least two blank pages. The date of issue must not be older than 10 years.

Copies of all pages containing entries.

6. **Household register (original)**

7.	<p>2 Copies of both parents' passports</p> <p>Copies of the pages containing personal data</p> <p>If the parent, who the child is intended to join, is not a German citizen, please submit 2 copies of his or her current residence permit in addition.</p>	
8.	<p>If <u>parents hold joint legal custody</u> and the child is intended to join only one parent: Notarized declaration of consent by the parent remaining in Myanmar</p>	
9.	<p>Proof of the family's place of domicile in Germany (e.g. registration certificate (not older than 6 months) or a copy of the ID card)</p>	
10.	<p><u>For minors above the age of 16</u>: Proof of good knowledge of the German language (level C1) or any equivalent evidence of the child's ability to fully integrate into the life circumstances in the Federal Republic of Germany (backed by the child's previous education and life circumstances).</p>
