## Family Reunion (Spouse/Registered Partner)

- The German Embassy in Yangon issues visas to applicants **living in the Republic of the Union of Myanmar**. If you intend to join your spouse or registered partner in Germany, you need to apply for a visa for family reunion (spouse/registered partner) (national visa).
- The application cannot be submitted earlier than 3 months before the travel date. **The processing time can be up to several weeks or months**. You are strongly encouraged to submit your application at least two months before your intended departure from Myanmar.
- You have to make an appointment via the [online appointment system](#).
- A **processing fee of 75 EUR (37,50 EUR for applicants who are less than 18 years old)** applies. It needs to be paid in USD at the embassy's exchange rate. There is no refund of the processing fee in case your application is denied or revoked.
- Please provide **original documents and two copies**. Original documents will be returned. All documents and certificates in Myanmar language have to be accompanied by a notarized translation into English.

| 4. | <b>Proof of proper marriage or establishment of registered partnership (original)</b><br><br>The proof's form depends on your personal circumstances. Appropriate proofs can be but are not limited to an affidavit (for Buddhists), a certificate of marriage (for Christians) or a Nikah Namah (Muslims).<br><br>For alternative forms of proof please contact the visa section of the embassy. |  |
