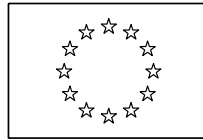

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Visa for visiting family and friends

- German Embassy Yangon issues visas to applicants **living in the Republic of the Union of Myanmar**. Furthermore Germany is **representing** the following countries referring to Schengen visa (not: national visa): **AUSTRIA, BELGIUM, DENMARK, FINLAND, GREECE, HUNGARY, ICELAND, LUXEMBURG, NETHERLANDS AND NORWAY**.
- The application cannot be submitted earlier than six months before the travel date. It should be submitted not less than 15 days before the intended travel date. You are strongly encouraged to submit your application as early as possible prior to your intended departure from Myanmar.
- You have to make an appointment with our partner VFS via the online appointment system: <https://www.vfsglobal.com/Germany/Myanmar/>
- The **visa application fee** for an adult is the equivalent of **EUR 80.00** / for children between the age of 6 and 12 years EUR 40.00. This non-refundable charge is payable in USD cash at the prevailing Embassy exchange rate when applying.
- **Original** documents must be submitted with **1 copy**. All documents in Myanmar language have to be accompanied by a notarized translation into English.
- Other nationals additionally have to provide a copy of the stay permit **and** re-entry visa for Myanmar valid for at least three months after the intended date of return to Myanmar.
- The Embassy reserves the right to ask for additional documents.

check

1. One **application form** duly completed in German or English and signed.
Please note that applications for children under the age of 18 years need to be signed by all persons holding legal custody for the child (usually both parents). These signatures must be effected in front of a visa officer. The applications are free of charge, available at the Embassy or on our homepage.

1 recent photograph no more than 6-months old, 35–40mm in width, white background, close up of your head and top of your shoulders so that your face takes up 70–80% of the photograph, in sharp focus and clear. No Photoshop!

2. **Original passport** valid for at least 3 months after the intended date of departure from the territory of the Schengen area. The passport/travel document must contain at least two blank pages and was issued within the last 10 years.

Provide a **photocopy of the passport data page**
If available, a **photocopy of previous Schengen** visas within last 3 years and valid USA/UK visas including entry and departure boarder police stamps.

3. a) **Letter of formal obligation** (Germany: “Verpflichtungserklärung”) signed by host and certified by the according authority (Germany: “Ausländerbehörde”).

	<p>b) A letter of invitation from the person the applicant is visiting in visiting country, which may take the form of sponsorship or private accommodation. The invitation letter has to include the address, period of stay and contact of the host. The letter together with a copy of the host's passport/ID has to be submitted along with the application form. Furthermore a statement of account of the applicant is required.</p> <p>For the period that the applicant is not staying with the host while in Germany and/or travelling to <u>other Schengen countries</u>, <u>hotel booking</u> is required.</p>	
4.	<p>Travel/medical insurance (coverage for medical expensed EUR 30,000 and valid for the entire Schengen area for the duration of the applicant's planned stay). It is a requirement that claims against the insurance company are recoverable in the Schengen States and/or Liechtenstein. The <u>insured party</u>, <u>policy validity period</u>, <u>geographical coverage</u> and <u>schedule of benefits</u> must be mentioned of the policy schedule/certificate. <i>Kindly note that insufficient proof of valid Travel Medical Insurance can lead to repatriation from the Schengen area.</i></p>	
5.	<p>Photocopy of National Registration Card</p>	
6.	<p>Photocopy of Household register (family member list)</p>	
7.	<p>Proof of the applicant's financial circumstances (such as 3 months of bank book statements, bank account statements, pay slips or fixed deposit statements).</p>	
8.	<p>A letter from the applicant's employer (with physical address and telephone number) confirming the holiday granted and confirming employment and duration of recruitment.</p>
