General Information

- The German Embassy in Yangon issues Schengen visas to applicants living in the Republic of the Union of Myanmar travelling to Germany. Furthermore Germany is currently representing the following countries, issuing Schengen visas (**not** national visas!) for short term stays on behalf of: AUSTRIA, BELGIUM, DENMARK, FINLAND, GREECE, HUNGARY, ICELAND and LUXEMBURG
- The visa application cannot be submitted earlier than six months before the travel date. It should be submitted at least fifteen days prior to the intended departure date. You are strongly encouraged to submit your application as early as possible prior to your intended departure from Myanmar.

- You have to make an appointment with our partner VFS Global via their [online appointment system](#).
- The visa application fee for an adult is the equivalent of EUR 90.00 / for children between the age of 6 and 12 years EUR 45.00. This non-refundable charge is payable in USD cash at the prevailing Embassy exchange rate when applying.
- Original documents must be submitted with 1 copy. All documents not in German or English have to be accompanied by a notarized translation into English or German.

The German Embassy reserves the right to ask for additional documents or personal appearance for an interview in special cases

Valid passport with at least 2 empty pages issued within the last 10 years and with at least 3 months validity after the scheduled return to Myanmar.	
1 photocopy of your passport's data page

Checklist for visas visiting family or friends	✓ Please tick
<p>For Minors: Application form signed by both parents / persons holding legal custody, birth certificate, copies of the parents passports data page. Additionally if travelling unaccompanied by parents: consent letter signed by both parents.</p>	
<p>Personal covering letter explaining the purpose of your trip</p>	
<p>Invitation letter with a copy of the data page of the host's passport and his/her residence permit, if applicable.</p>	
<p>Flight reservation, rail bookings, others (please note that you are not required to submit proof of purchase of tickets and that you should not purchase non-refundable tickets prior to having been granted a visa)</p>	
<p>For the period that the applicant is not staying with the host and/or travelling to other Schengen countries proof of accommodation is required.</p>	
<p>Proof of sufficient funds for the visit: If sponsored: Verpflichtungserklärung (formal obligation letter) of your sponsor If self-sponsored: Personal original bank statement / original bank book of the past 3 months with sufficient funds</p>	
<p>Proof of applicants economic circumstances: Personal original bank account / bank book statement of the past three months If employed: Letter from employer with address and telephone number stating duration of employment and approved leave. Copy of valid trade license and registration of company. If self-employed: Valid trade license and registration of company If unemployed / retired etc.: Proof of income of means of subsistence</p>	
<p>Travel Health insurance (coverage for medical expensed EUR 30,000 including medical repatriation and valid for the entire Schengen area for the duration of the applicant's planned stay)</p>	
<p>Photocopy of National Registration Card</p>	
<p>Photocopy of Household register (family member list)</p>	
<p>Non Myanmar nationals: Non Myanmar nationals: Copy of Foreign Registration Certificate and re-entry visa valid for your return to Myanmar.</p>	

Submission of the above-mentioned documents does not guarantee that a visa is granted. Submission of incomplete documentation or refusal to appear for a special visa interview may result in the rejection of your application.
